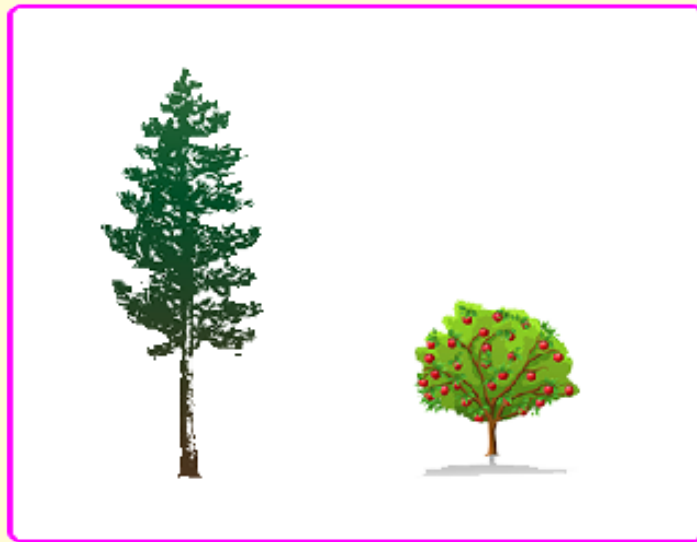


# Degrees of Comparison

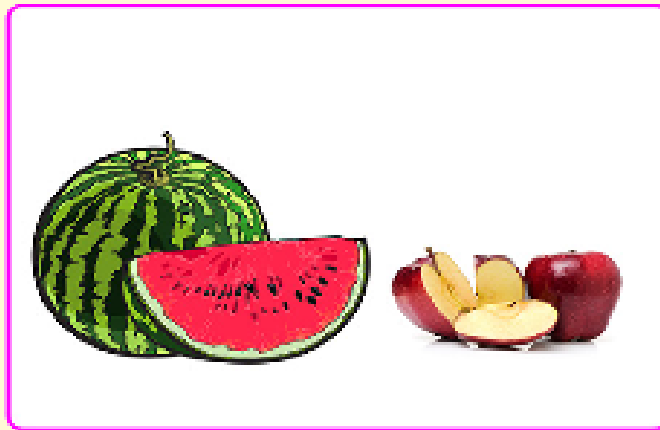
